# 2024/25 VJBL PROGRAM PARENT INFORMATION

## **About Geelong United Basketball**

Geelong United Basketball (GUB) aims to create pathways for every player, coach and official to achieve excellence according to their desires and abilities.

GUB participates in the Victorian Junior Basketball League (VJBL), which is Australia's largest junior basketball competition. The season runs from November 2024 to September 2025, with breaks for school holidays. Games are played on Friday nights, with over 1200 teams from 54 associations, competing across five different age groups at more than 80 venues across the state.

## **Geelong United Basketball Commitment**

With selection to the GUB VJBL program, parents and players should recognize that participation is a major commitment of time, effort, and money, and that there is no guarantee of court time.

VJBL basketball is for players (and their families) with a serious intention to achieve and to contribute to team performance even when this involves some sacrifices to the individual. It is not for players wishing to necessarily play with other players of their choice or a specific team or coach.

All players wanting to be considered for GUB VJBL selection must register via PlayHQ and attend tryouts. (Click here to register for trials)

Whilst we require a large commitment by players and parents alike, we believe basketball offers many rewards, which may include strong friendships that will be forged during the years that children are involved with GUB.

## **Key Expectations**

- It is mandatory for all GUB VJBL players to participate in our Community Competition. If you are new to GUB it is expected that you will take the appropriate steps to contact and register with one of our community clubs. You can find the contact details for all of our community clubs on the GUB website.
- All players must always be financial with the GUB VJBL program. If you become unfinancial you will be deemed ineligible to participate.
- GUB players are required to train and play, irrespective of any other commitments. You are
  choosing to be a part of the GUB VJBL pathway, and thus you are committing to
  becoming the best basketballer that you can be.
- Court time in the VJBL teams is not guaranteed and will be given at the coach's discretion.
- VJBL training will be held on Saturdays or Sundays depending on your allotted training time. Some teams may opt for an optional additional session during the week.
- Home and away games are played across Victoria. Travelling to away games is a
  requirement and is a commitment for those choosing to be a part of the GUB VJBL
  program. Players and parents are required to make their own way to games.
- All players and parents must agree to and abide by the GUB and Basketball Victoria codes of conduct.

- Trials A levy of \$15.50 will be charged upon registration for trials.
  - This fee covers coaching and court hire for the trials sessions
- Registration The annual GUB Player Levy is \$580 per player. The first (non- refundable) payment of \$250 is due upon acceptance of a VJBL offer, which secures your position in the team. There will then be three future payments of \$110 that will be due throughout the season.

The player levy amount is determined based on the costs incurred by GUB for the following:

- Court hire for training sessions
- VJBL Grading phase team entry
- VJBL Regular season team entry
- GUB VJBL Tournament Entry (Nov 2024)
- Coaches (education, apparel, appreciation gift)
- Administration staff
- Equipment (match basketballs and training equipment)
- Presentation and awards
- Entry costs for teams attending Country Championships and National Classic
- Casual shooting (AWA Stadium)
- Weekly fee Approx. \$20 per player per week (covers weekly game fee, additional training session (if applicable)). This amount will be confirmed by each team's Team Manager.
- GUB Uniform & Apparel

Compulsory uniform items for Season 2024/25 as follows

- Playing singlet (New Balance reversible)
- Playing shorts
- Reversible training singlet

Optional items also available for purchase:

- Warm-up top
- Backpack
- Hoodie
- Trackpants
- Socks

All uniforms will be ordered online via the New Balance shop, size fittings will be held during trials.

- Acceptance of position due 10<sup>th</sup> of Oct and first installment of \$250 due
- Second instalment \$110 due 17 February 2025
- Third instalment \$110 due 17 April 2025
- Fourth instalment \$110 due 17 June 2025
